- WESTLAKE FLAGS ON HILLIARD BLVD
  - With the help of Dr. Goggin, the City has approved the placement of 20 Westlake flags on Hilliard Blvd. The City is also providing the poles, brackets and manpower to hang them.
  - Mr. Wilson has helped us secure a vendor with a phenomenal price for doublesided flags at \$38 per flag.
  - The City has indicated there is typically a 6-month window on the flags due to wear and tear and will discuss the district's financial participation in the replacement flags.
- WDAB FUNDS FALL/WINTER RECONCILIATION
  - Jen Rujawitz, our treasurer, met with Tony to review and reconcile fall sports and their purchases of items approved in the 2018 WDAB budget.
  - o Cross Country is just now ordering their shelter tent.
  - \$5500 for a tennis shed is still in limbo.
  - We approved another \$250 for an additional hockey helmet within their approved funding.
  - The Executive Board approved a \$1000 request from the girls and boys bowling teams for tournament fees
