  - Motion to approve Tony's budget of \$43,851 with all the asks from coaches the \$43,851 was the approved amount from WDAB

- All uniform requests, if provided by WDAB, must be approved by Board to ensure following guidelines
- Questions regarding the amounts asked and where these numbers came from Tony gets requests from teams and works with vendors to determine an amount needed to purchase items needed
- Discussion regarding is this it for requests or are teams able to place requests later in the year to WDAB? Will teams who might have been denied funds from WDAB create an issue with families donating/volunteering next year?
- Tony feels the budget is good does not think that there will be issues feels the amount of almost \$50K is a good budget. Not many school booster programs can provide almost \$50K to the benefit the athletes.


- Thanks for approving the budget
